



SCIENTIFIC RATIONALE

We are pleased to invite you to the 17th International Workshop on Neonatology and Pediatrics (virtual Edition) - Cagliari, Italy. This follows the success of the previous editions which saw the overall presence of about 11,500 participants. This 17th Workshop is an important milestone and is recognized by national and international scientific societies. Some of the world's most renowned specialists from more than 60 different countries have been present in Cagliari in these years. They have created a network of scientific and human relations that have changed, improved and enriched us all. This year's meeting is organized in collaboration with UMEMPS, UENPS, SIP (Italian Society of Pediatrics) SIN (Italian Society of Neonatology), HSPM (Hellenic Society of Perinatal Medicine), S.I.P.Ped (Italian Society of Pediatric Psychology and Italian-Romanian Pediatric Society).

The different sections are focused on the latest developments in different fields of Neonatology and Pediatrics, towards a personalized medicine, anticipating the new frontiers of practice and research and with the participation of famous experts of different countries. The meeting is dedicated to neonatologists, pediatricians, obstetricians, perinatologists, pathologists, laboratory researchers and all those who work with newborns and children. We look forward to welcoming you to this traditional appointment to discuss topics of the present and keep us up to virtually date on the latest results, both in clinical practice and research in Neonatology and Pediatrics. We hope in the next year to guest you again in presence in Cagliari.

Abstracts will not be published if there are plagiarism issues. In particular, abstracts will be rejected if plagiarism exceeds 20%. Abstracts will be published only if written in good English. The authors must be aware that good English is essential for acceptance of the abstracts.


The learning test can be performed at the end of the webinar, after following the training activity for at least 90% of its duration.


To complete the questionnaire, the learners have up to 3 days after the start and with the possibility of a maximum number of 5 attempts.


