Publications

- Author of more than 700 articles (of which 490 on PubMed and 566 on Scopus) in International and National Journals.
- Author of 34 books: 8 in English, the first published book on neonatal nephrology (*Neonatal Nephrology in Progress*), 1 book on history of birth (*Children of the Mother Goddess. History of Mediterranean Neonates*), 1 on *Developmental Nephrology: from embryology to metabolomics*, 1 on *Kidney Development in Renal Pathology*. His last books in English are: *Metabolomics and microbiomics: individualized medicine from the fetus to the adult*, published by Academic Press (Elsevier) in 2017, and *New Technologies and Perinatal Medicine: Prediction and Prevention of Pregnancy Complications*, coauthored with M. Hod, V. Berghella, M. D’Alton, G. Di Renzo and E. Gratacos and published by CRC, London in 2019. The last books in Italian regard Precision Medicine, Diet and Microbiome and the gut, COVID-19 in children and Pioneer bacteria, pillars of health.
- He was also Editor of 13 Proceedings of Congresses (10 in English), Guest Editor in *Journal of Maternal-Fetal Neonatal Medicine, Journal of Chemotherapy, Journal of Pediatric and Neonatal Individualized Medicine, Current Pharmaceutical Design and Current Medicinal Chemistry*.
